Why amend the landscape code?

- Population continues to grow in the area and less water to accommodate this growth.
- Conserve water and use it more efficiently.
- Sections are confusing and need clarification.
- Missing information/topics and need to bring it up to date.



Amendments/Additions

- **Tree preservation, removal, and replacement, and protection**
- Turf limitations
- Landscape design hydrozones, plant diversity, planting guidelines
- Plant ratios applied to urban and rural areas of the County
- □ Irrigation design
- Buffers and screening between land uses
- Professional and inspection requirements
- Plant List
- Parking Lot landscaping



Planning Commission and Board of County Commissioners

- PC Study Session May 21, 2024
- BOCC Study Session September 3, 2024
- PC Public Hearing October 15, 2024, vote for recommendation for approval, 3-3 vote, vote failed, denial recommendation to the Board.
 - Too many restrictions and requirements with the amendment.
 - Additional requirements would add to development and housing costs.
 - Questioned whether the water saved outweighed the additional administrative and design burden.



Staff Recommendation

Staff is requesting approval of Landscape Land Development Code and Development Application Manual Amendments.
