11:00 AM *IT Capital Assets Funds Appropriation to 2026

The purpose of this study session was to obtain the Board's authorization for two related actions, which

will be formally appropriated upon adoption of the second-quarter budget review. The first is to authorize the appropriation of funding for capital assets that were previously approved for replacement and already have assigned capital asset numbers. The second is to approve new capital assets and authorize the appropriation of associated funding for additional hardware replacements. These assets would be used to purchase hardware to facilitate the migration of servers from our cloud hosting provider to the County's data center. The original plan was to complete this migration in 2027; however, recent changes to Microsoft's server licensing rules would result in an additional \$130,000 in expenses if licenses are renewed in October. This request proposes to reallocate like-for-like expenses from 2027 to 2026, with no new funds being requested.

A background of the request was presented.

Microsoft has ended the SPLA licensing program that the County currently uses to license the Windows server in the cloud. Staff provided further background information surrounding the options and costs to ensure compliance in the cloud.

Staff are requesting that the board authorize the appropriation of funding for capital assets previously approved for replacement and already assigned capital asset numbers, and to approve new capital assets and authorize the appropriation of associated funding for additional hardware replacements.

Google discussions are ongoing for certain services such as backups. This would be at no additional cost to the County.

Commissioner asked for clarification regarding budgets tied to the contracts and the October deadline.

Commissioner asked regarding the deadlines and timeframe for the switch and the cost of assets.

Commissioner asked about which budget will the funding for the assets come from.

Commissioner inquired as to possible risk for the switch.
