3. SCFD REPORT

SCFD Board meeting held 9/25. 1. Tier III distribution numbers were released. Final budget released and approved at the 10/23 SCFD Board meeting. 45 eligibility applications were received; 31 are complete, 5 are from Arapahoe County. Tier III materials available for pickup next week at SCFD. SCFD Mixer scheduled for November 19 at the Clifford Still Museum. Arapahoe County celebration event: October 29, 6-8 PM at 5334 S. Proposed changes included additions related to: Municipal org funding caps; Festival project prioritization; Clarified GOS eligibility and one-county rule; Examples and definitions of county impact; Score threshold (discussed for future implementation); Organizational accountability and budget clarity; Application clarity and completeness expectations.

The Council discussed and refined the proposed changes detailed in the attached document.

Trina Campbell moved to approve the changes to the Arapahoe County Application Guidelines as written in the attached. Joanna Floribus seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

As part of the discussion, the Council determined that a review of the scoring rubric and application instructions will happen separately in Spring.
