The purpose of this study session was to brief the Board of County Commissioners on the Arapahoe County Cybersecurity Consortium Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA), which establishes a collaborative framework for participating government and quasi-government partners to share cybersecurity information, coordinate response efforts, support regional planning and exercises, and strengthen cybersecurity resilience across Arapahoe County. The Director of Information Technology (IT) and Chief Information Security Officer respectfully requested the Board of County Commissioners' approval of the IGA to authorize Arapahoe County's participation in the Arapahoe County Cybersecurity Consortium and authorization for the Director of IT to sign the IGA and any related agreements.

A background of the request was presented.

Staff provided insight on the Arapahoe County Cybersecurity Consortium and its intent. IT Dept. have been discussing with sister cities throughout the county surrounding sharing resources and creating an IGA.

Commissioner noted the reciprocal agreements with law enforcements, public works, etc. and commented that this IGA aligns with the work being done in Arapahoe County.

Commissioner thanked staff for their initiative with this IGA.

Commissioner made comment regarding the county being able to work proactively with the partnerships established.

The purpose of this study session was Open Spaces staff requested that the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) approve an easement to be granted to the City of Centennial for construction of a traffic signal on Dove Valley Regional Park property at East Broncos Parkway and South Blackhawk

Street. Staff also requested that the BOCC authorize the Open Spaces director to execute the agreement. The draft easement is attached.

The background of the request was presented.

The city of Centennial had approached the Open Spaces department to request that an easement be granted for a traffic signal be installed at E. Broncos Parkway and S. Blackhawk Street on Dove Valley Regional Park property.

A map was displayed to show the traffic signal easement location.

Commissioner asked if Public Works department was aware of the easement.

Commissioner confirmed with staff from the county attorney's office if they were comfortable moving forward with draft easement.
