Canyon Peak Power LLC is expecting to construct Grading, Erosion, and Sediment Controls (GESC) for the Canyon Peak Power Station project. It is our intent to provide a guarantee for the proper construction of the items defined within the engineer's cost estimate from the GESC Report that is satisfactory to Arapahoe County's Engineering Division and Board of County Commissioners.

Canyon Peak Power LLC is anticipating three major categories of control measures to be constructed within three phases. Phase 1 will be the Initial Phase of installation of best management practices (BMPs) and other control measure to the site prior to construction starting. Phase 2 will be the Interim Phase, which will require installation of control measures as site grading progresses during construction. Phase 3 is Final Phase, where permanent control measures will be installed prior to the end of construction.

A letter of credit can be provided for final agreed to amount for the GESC control measures until implementation and final stabilization occurs for the project.
