Submission of a letter of agreement between the subdivider and utility serving the site shall be deemed sufficient to establish that adequate provision for electric or, if applicable, natural gas service to a proposed subdivision has been made. In addition, CORE has existing overhead electric facilities along the western boundary of the property installed in the 1940s. The existing facilities are prescriptive rights and have senior rights to the 20-foot road right of way dedication in 2020; reception No. E0103969. 	The applicant spoke with Brooks Kaufman, and he explained that the property owners are required to grant a utility easement pursuant to this subdivision exemption, which easement area must cover 15' on the north, east, and south sides of the property and 30' on the west side of the property. The agency said that this easement may be granted via a notation on the plat, and that no stand- alone easement agreement is required, and that this easement will satisfy all of CORE's comments. The plat has been revised to show these easements.
