2:30 PM *Letter of Support for the University of Colorado Anschutz

The purpose of this study session was to discuss a request of the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office to write a letter of support for the University of Colorado Anschutz regarding efforts to collect information from individuals experiencing incarceration that have a history of high-risk medical and/or mental health diagnoses. This effort will include on-site visits from staffers at the University of Colorado and some non-identifiable information sharing.

Representatives from the Sheriff's Office explained how a grant that was recently awarded to the University of Colorado Anschutz would be used.

It was stated that there is an estimated 60% of the inmates have issues with mental illness.

Commissioner asked about statistics from study. Staff confirmed that statistics will be provided to the BOCC.

The Board expressed endorsement for the Sheriff's Office to write a letter of support.

Senior Assistant County Attorney Tiffanie Bleau explained that the Board could authorize the Sheriff to sign the letter of support.
