2023 Strategic Plan

The purpose of this study session was to provide an information on Arapahoe Library District, its impact and programs.

Administrative Item: Giving Shannon Carter the authority to sign the purchase and sale agreement with Denver Water.

Passed 4-0. Commissioner Campbell-Swanson absent and excused.

The motion was made by Commissioner Baker and duly seconded by Commissioner Summey that the Board go into an executive session pursuant to section 24-6-402(4)(a) & (e) of the Colorado Revised Statutes to discuss the potential transfer of High Line Canal property to Arapahoe County and to instruct negotiators regarding same, and also to go into executive session under 24-6-402(4)(e) of the Colorado Revised Statutes to receive legal advice regarding the following:

- 1) Mediation in the appeal of the Jurinsky v. Human Services case, and
- 2) Settlement discussions in the appeal of the PERA v. Counties case and related matters.

The motion passed 4-0. Commissioner Campbell-Swanson absent and excused.

The meeting was adjourned.
