Plan Purpose

The Tri-Cities Homelessness Plan of Action was built from data collection and engagement with stakeholders and provides comprehensive strategies and action steps designed to address homelessness in the Tri-Cities region.



Plan Development



Methodology

- University of Denver (DU) studies designed to understand the root causes of chronic (individual) and family homelessness in the Tri-Cities region
- Political, Economic, Social, Technological, Environmental, and Legal (PESTEL) analysis conducted by the Tri-Cities Homelessness Policy Committee
- 53 oral stakeholder interviews



Cumulative Findings

- •Strengthen local and regional coordination
- •Address the unique needs of families and individuals experiencing homelessness in the Tri-Cities region
- Coordinate homeless activities among city staff
- •Streamline access to homeless services and provide navigation support
- Increase participation among homeless service organizations in data collection
- Provide an alternative to law enforcement to proactively respond to constituent concerns regarding people experiencing homelessness and connect them to local services
- •Leverage partnerships with public and private partners to address the health and behavioral health of people experiencing chronic homelessness
- •Expand housing opportunities to increase successful exits from homelessness



- Create partnerships with workforce programs
- Create employment opportunities

- Prevent families from becoming homeless
