Existing and Proposed Land Development Code Language for Commercial Injection Facilities at 3-3.4

EXISTING

J. INJECTION WELLS

Commercial injection wells are subject to obtaining the required "Certificate of Designation" as well as all applicable State requirements. Injection well sites shall be located adjacent to paved arterial roads. Hours of operation shall be limited to 7:00 am to 7:00 pm.

PROPOSED

J. INJECTION WELLS

- 1. Commercial injection wells are subject to obtaining the required "Certificate of Designation" as well as all applicable State requirements.
- 2. Injection well sites shall be located adjacent to paved arterial roads.
- 3. Commercial injection facilities may conduct injection operations on a 24 hours/7 days a week basis. However, commercial injection facilities are prohibited from receiving or accepting trucks transporting produced water, flowback water or any other exploration and production materials for disposal by injection except during the hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm.

New Definition to add to the LDC:

Flowback or Flowback Water

Flowback water refers to the return of injected fluids at the wellhead after hydraulic fracturing. Flowback water is generally disposed in injection wells
