




Chalk Lines & Vines – May 15-16, 2021



Arapahoe County Fair – July 22-25, 2021

The Fair Executive Team have continued to meet and strategize a plan for the 2021 Fair given current public health conditions. We will continue to work with Tri-Count Health to plan out multiple scenarios for hosting the annual Fair depending on shifting health regulations. The following are goals lined out for the 2021 Fair.

- Support and host 4-H completion projects through COVID-19 restrictions.
- Showcase and host a safe event for staff and patrons.
- Create a scalable event to follow restrictions as they change.
- Create options for "sessions" during fair to increase attendance numbers
- Create options for separate ticketed events to prime entertainment. This will support cost recovery efforts.
