The purpose of this study session was to provide information on the status of Colorado's state legislative session, including potential impacts to Arapahoe County, and seek Board direction on legislative positions or specific advocacy activities.

House Bill (HB) 23-1113 was reviewed and the fiscal impact was discussed. The Board agreed to support this bill.

Commissioner Campbell-Swanson was chosen to represent Arapahoe County and testify.

House Bill (HB) 23-1115 was reviewed and discussed. The Board agreed to support this bill.

An update regarding Senate Bill (SB) 23-064 was provided. The Board was in agreement with the staff recommendation to monitor this bill.

A review of HB 23-1100 was provided. The majority of the Board was in agreement to monitor.

Commissioner Summey, Holen, Campbell-Swanson and Warren-gully agreed to support the bill; Commissioner Baker favored monitoring the bill.

There was discussion on the difference of monitoring vs supporting.

Commissioner Campbell-Swanson expressed why she supports HB 23-1100.

It was stated that this bill would not affect the Sheriff's Office.

There was discussion on a potential bill that would affect processing domestic violence cases, and what the purpose of the bill is.

There was discussion on how this would impact Arapahoe County.

Staff stated they would gather more information, then report back to the Board.

The meeting came to a pause in order for the Board to go into executive session.

The motion was made by Commissioner Baker and duly seconded by Commissioner Summey that the Board go into executive session pursuant to Sections 24-6-402(4)(b) &(e) of the Colorado Revised Statutes to instruct negotiators and receive legal advice regarding proposed middle housing zoning preemption legislation

The motion passed 5-0.
