Purpose and Request:

The purpose of this request is for the adoption of a resolution approving the Arbitration stipulation listed below

Background and Discussion: This stipulation is the result of an agreement reached between the taxpayer and the County regarding a reduction in the amount of property tax owed, settling an arbitration request of a taxpayer protest. The following schedule number has been stipulated to (for the tax years 2021/2022):

*Comparable market sales indicate that adjustment to this value is correct.
