Approval of a Confidential Litigation Settlement Agreement

Purpose and Request:

The purpose of this request is to obtain authorization for the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners to sign a settlement agreement that has been negotiated in the pending litigation of *Tomikoyoshi Wilson*, *Personal Representative of the Estate of Mustafa Hussain v. The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Arapahoe*, Case No. 2020CV31937 (Arapahoe County District Court), a review of which was previously provided to the Board in executive session.

Background and Discussion: The Wilson litigation has been pending since 2020. An agreement between all

parties resolving the litigation has been reached.
