Veteran Services Office June 2022 Monthly Report

#### **Purpose and Request:**

The purpose of this report is to communicate the services provided to veterans and their families by the Arapahoe County Veterans Service Officer during the month of June 2022.

**Background and Discussion:** The Colorado Department of Veterans Services requires assistance to veterans and their families in compliance with Sections 28-5-801 et seq., Colorado Revised Statutes, in receiving their benefits such as, but not limited to:

Burials: Provide veterans within Arapahoe County the information regarding their burial allowance

Advise and assist family members of veterans collection of death pension

Health Services: Assist veterans in processing claims for medical benefits Assist and coordinate with veterans'

Medicaid cases

Claims: Prepare, present and appeal claims for VA benefits on behalf of Arapahoe County veterans and their dependents

**Alternatives:** This document is a state form required by the State of Colorado to be submitted monthly as application for monetary benefits payable to the County General Fund in accordance with Section 28-5-707 Colorado Revised Statutes.

# **Fiscal Impact:**

The County receives \$28,400 annually from the State of Colorado for the services provided to veterans in Arapahoe County. There is also a positive fiscal impact to individual veterans and claimants through successful claims recoveries.
